The Executive Council of the General Anthroposophical Society recommends that you resign from the Society. You are asked to notify us of your resignation according to Number 5, Paragraph 1, of the Statutes.

Should you not wish to follow our recommendation, the Council intends to expel you from the Society according to Number 5, Paragraph 2 of the Statutes.

You have the opportunity to express your reaction before the decision is made, but must do so by January 5, 2007. If you would like a personal hearing, please let us know by the same date. In that case, the hearing would take place at the Goetheanum on January 15th or 16th, 2007.

You belong to a group which, for some time now, and sometimes in a polemical fashion, has been attacking the General Anthroposophical Society from outside and burdening it from within.

Since 1993, these attacks from without have largely appeared in the periodical GELEBTE WEIHNACHTSTAGUNG, and, since 2002, on the internet site www.888GOYA.org, in addition. In both these places, two persons who resigned from the Society in 1989 and have since been attacking it from the outside, seem to have been particularly influential ("wichtige Meinungsmacher"). Their names are Werner and Michaela Jordan, of Horgen (Switzerland).

The group is burdening our society from within by presenting excessive motions at certain meetings, whereby they try to determine the course of the meeting and monopolize the subject matter against the intentions of the Council and the majority of the members.

We look forward to your report ("Bericht").
